### **God of Second Chances** John 21:1-19

**Introduction:** We read today the account of "the third time that Jesus was manifested to the disciples, after He was raised from the dead." (John 21:14) The resurrection appearance culminated with a conversation between Jesus and Peter. Many of us, like Peter, have denied Jesus along the way. For a season, we have abandoned our faith and fellowship with Jesus. Like Peter, we need a second chance.
