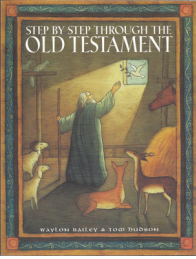

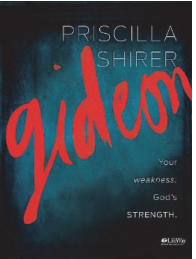
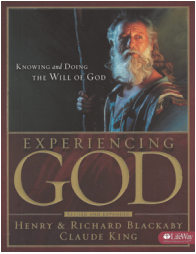


Step By Step through the Old Testament

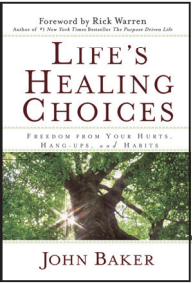
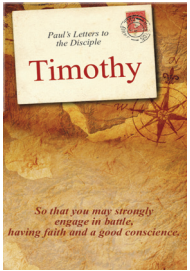


Gideon: Your Weakness. God's Strength
