



March 13 is the start of Daylight Saving Time, so be sure to move your clock FORWARD Saturday evening.

Another difficulty next Sunday will be the ZYDECO MARATHON covering a large portion of Lafayette. Roads throughout much of the city will be blocked, and this almost completely surrounds First Baptist. While police will open intersections briefly when runners are not passing, in prior years extremely long delays were experienced by members on their way to Sunday services.
