According to IRS Regulations, your year-end donations must meet the following deadlines in order to receive credit for calendar year 2016 tax purposes.

IN PERSON: Contributions must be received *in hand* by **December 29, 2016**. The church office will be open until 4:30 p.m. on Thursday, December 29 to receive contributions that will qualify as a 2016 donation, so please mark your calendar accordingly.

BY MAIL: Any donations received via mail will be treated as a 2016 donation if the postmark date on the envelope is *on or before* **December 31, 2016**.

ON-LINE GIVING: Contributions may also be made through the church website at www.fbclaf.org/give. On-line gifts must be **processed on-line by December 31, 2016**.

For information and assistance regarding Qualified Charitable Distributions (QCD) up to \$100K directly from an IRA to the church, contact the accounting office.
