

New Focus On Compassion Ministries Begins Soon

Several years ago, First Baptist members engaged in "Do Something" to determine a vision for the future ministry for our church. Six initiatives were developed, including an increased involvement in compassion ministries in our local community. Since that time, many of us have worked with some of our church's ministry partners to volunteer, donate, or participate in other ways to help impoverished families in the community.

Beginning in September, we will have perhaps the greatest opportunity yet to minister to these needs through a partnership with **Escape From Poverty**. This local organization offers a practical Christian discipleship program targeted to those who are



struggling financially and in other areas of life. Through the **Success Series Power Courses**, participants find hope, success, and life transformation within a faithbased environment.




The **Success Series** covers life skills such as budgeting, grocery shopping, dealing with credit issues, writing a resume, job interviews, getting organized, setting goals, dressing for success, health and nutrition, effective communication, and more. Character building is also an important component, and the life of Joseph is studied to provide spiritual insight for life transformation.

First Baptist will host these classes on Wednesday evening beginning in early October, and we need your help. Each participant needs a mentor to offer guidance, friendship, and to build a relationship with them. We need budget counselors to help participants develop workable budgets and review finances with participants. We also need people with skills to teach or assist participants with the various topics mentioned above.

Training for those who would like to be a part of this ministry begins Wednesday, September 12. There will be a table near the Church Library beginning next Sunday with Escape From Poverty representatives who can give you more details and answer questions.

If you are not available on Wednesday evenings but would like to volunteer in compassion ministry, **Escape From Poverty** has numerous other opportunities for both individuals and businesses.
